Dear Dr. McKelvey:

I have discussed your letter of July 3 with the two candidates to your training program. As a result they asked me to find out your opinion about what they have in mind.

They are very interested in having a chance to work with Dr. Franzen in nutrition and physiology of cattle. But also they claim that, considering Brazilian conditions, it seems desirable to receive a training as broad as possible in animal husbandry and also in poultry.

Their final question is to know whether you would aprove such a program which would be split into two phases, one in Colombia and another in Mexico. Of course they are unable at this time to indicate for how long they should stay in each place since at this time they don't know the programs envolved.

Their names, as you have requested, are Mario Salvo de Brito and Paulo Henrique de Rezende Murgel.

As for the process relative to The Rocke feller grant, this week the Government Message to the
State Assembly was approved in second discussion. The
third discussion is to come soon and it is more concerned with the final form mostly, if I am correct.
For this reason I am sending to you the list of materiel which I hope is in agreement with your orientation as for its organization. Since I estimate
that your grant is to be offered in three similar instalments during three years, the total amount in-
